
New distribution of the French legislation for work-study schemes (September 5, 2018 bill "Act for the freedom to choose one's own future career")

By choosing to pay the training levy in France, your company supports quality training for our students and helps them meet their career goals. Contributions to work-study programmes and to the training levy have been merged into one single tax benefitting on-the-job training and work-study programmes, the CUFPA (Contribution Unique à la Formation Professionnelle et à l'Alternance). The amount of the fee is based on your company's gross payroll (0,68%). Starting from 2022, the fee will be collected by the URSSAF (French agency for the collection of social security contributions) on the basis of a monthly declaration. Both declaration and payment should be completed online. The France Compétences agency is in charge of collecting the fee.

The training levy comes in two parts:

- One percentage goes to work-study schemes. Formerly known as the quota d'apprentissage, it amounts to 87% of the levy.fraction ;
- The remainder funds technical and hands-on training (excluding work-study schemes and other training schemes formerly known as "hors quota" or "barème"); this fraction amounts to 13% of the levy.
